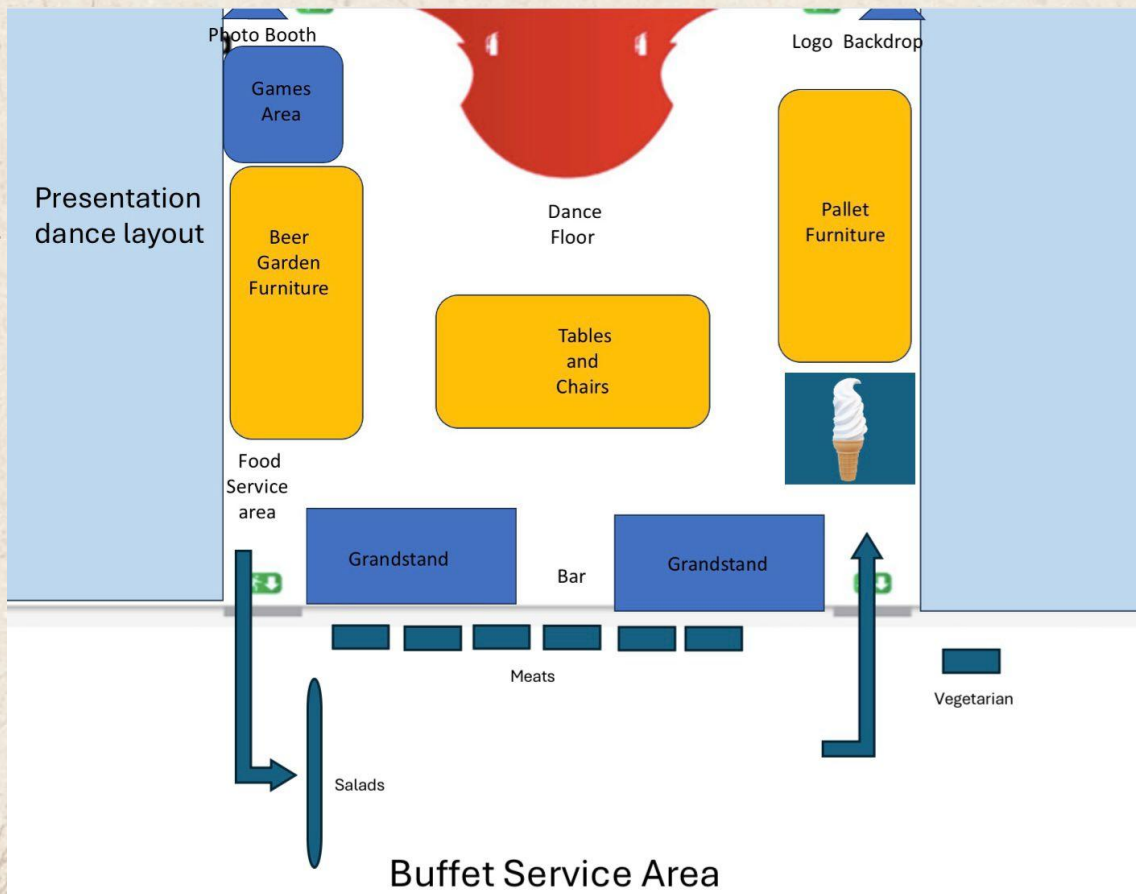

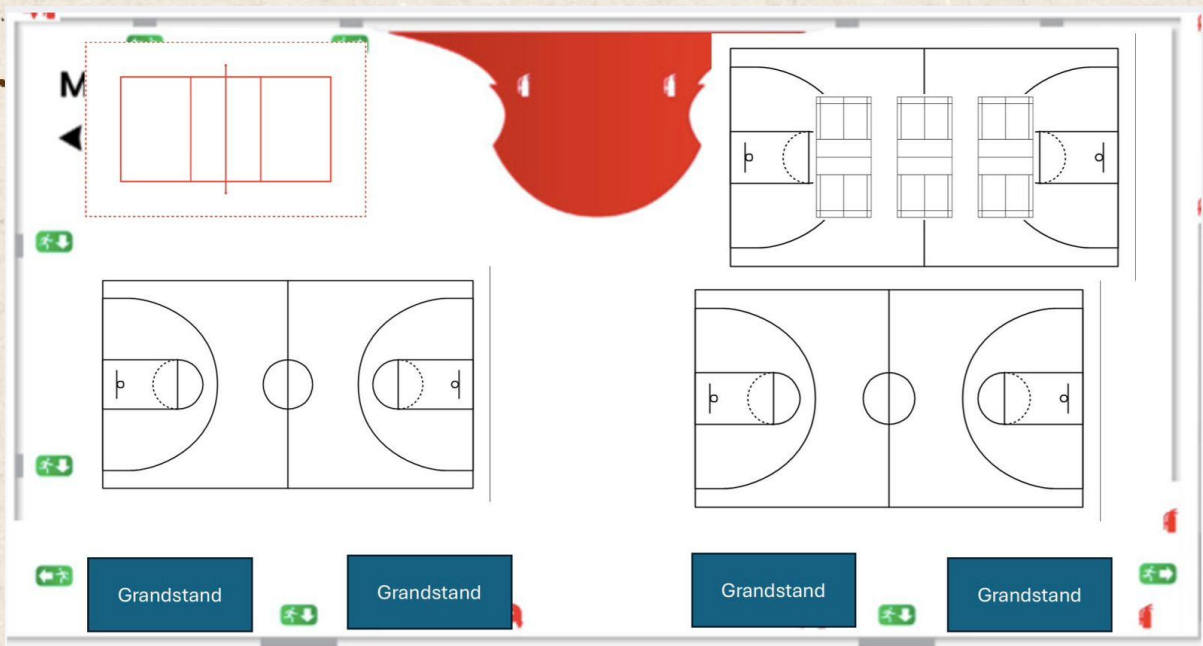

Torch Bearer Biography



Peng Tok Chum

At 90 years old, Peng Tok Chum is a true pioneer of SACSA basketball, having participated in the very first Easter Tournament in 1959. He represented the then Northern Transvaal Province in men's basketball alongside his three older brothers.

Peng's passion for the sport has become a lasting family legacy. His children continued the tradition by competing in the Easter Tournaments, and today two of his grandchildren proudly follow in his footsteps.

Remarkably, Peng remains active and committed to fitness, training daily at the gym and recently completing an impressive three-minute plank.



Pearl Kamson

Pearl Kamson began her Easter Tournament journey in 1965 at the age of 17, representing the then Northern Transvaal women's basketball team, who went on to win the tournament that year.

During her playing career, she also represented the Northern Transvaal National Ladies Basketball Team.

Together with her late husband, Cecil Kamson, Pearl played a pivotal role in reviving the Northern Transvaal Chinese Sports Association in the 1980s, dedicating countless hours to coaching and developing basketball within the Pretoria community.

Pearl participated in the Easter Tournament for an extraordinary 35 years, playing until the age of 52 and sharing the court with her three daughters.



Neal Ho-Tong

Neal Ho-Tong, now 68, began his involvement in the Easter Tournament in the late 1970s, representing Northern Transvaal in basketball before later competing in soccer. He subsequently served as Soccer Director for both SACSA and Northern Gauteng.

In 1972, Neal was selected for the Northern Transvaal U16 National Soccer Team. Beyond team sports, he is also a 3rd Dan black belt in karate.

Sport remains a proud family tradition for Neal. All of his children have represented Northern Gauteng in basketball at the Easter Tournament, and his sons have also achieved black belt status in karate.



Claudia Accone

Claudia has represented Northern Gauteng in volleyball since 2003 at the Easter Tournament.

Claudia has achieved Protea Colours in Wushu, a Chinese Martial Art. She has also represented Johannesburg at the senior inter-regional volleyball tournament.

Passionate about giving back, Claudia has played a key role in developing the Mavericks Stars Basketball Club since 2016 and the Spiker-Roo Volleyball Club since 2011, while also serving in leadership roles within the Transvaal Chinese Association and as President of the Johannesburg Volleyball Union.

The Easter Tournament legacy runs strongly in the Accone family. Claudia's husband represented Southern Gauteng in pistol shooting, ten-pin bowling, and golf, while her daughters currently represent Southern Gauteng in basketball and volleyball, continuing the family's proud sporting tradition.



Kevin San Fat

Kevin San Fat represents Northern Gauteng in volleyball and has been a proud participant in the Easter Tournament since 2006.

Beyond volleyball, Kevin earned his National Colours in Chinese Kung Fu from 1998 to 2004 and proudly represented South Africa at the International Martial Arts Competition in Taiwan in 2004.

Deeply committed to promoting martial arts, Kevin has volunteered his time and skills through performances at the Nan-Hua Temple, Hing Ning Old Age Home, and the All Africa Games in 1999.

Kevin continues to give back to the community through his involvement with the Spiker-Roo Volleyball Club and by contributing to the development of volleyball at Crawford Sandton International School.

Sport is a strong family tradition for Kevin, with his sister and nieces actively participating in the Easter Tournament, competing in volleyball and basketball.



Danielle de Pinho

Danielle's Easter Tournament journey began in 2003 when, at just six years old, she represented Northern Gauteng in mini basketball. Today, basketball remains at the heart of her sporting career as she proudly represents Swaziland at the tournament.

In addition to basketball, Danielle is a former Junior South African Kickboxing Champion. Beyond her athletic achievements, she is deeply committed to community outreach, working closely with initiatives such as the Sunflower Fund and the Niki Duarte Project.

Her greatest pride are her sons, and she eagerly looks forward to supporting them as they begin writing their own sporting stories. Basketball runs in the family—her father also competed in the Easter Tournament, and this year marks a special moment as Danielle steps onto the court to face her sister for the very first time.



Joshua Why

Joshua first participated in the Easter Tournament at the age of seven, representing Northern Gauteng in basketball. He continues to represent Northern Gauteng today, having since developed a strong passion for volleyball.

The Easter Tournament runs deep in Joshua's family. His grandfather played basketball for Matabeleland (now Zimbabwe) in the 60's and was responsible for making team pennants to exchange with other teams — a cherished tradition of that era. Joshua's mother, sister, aunts, uncles and cousins have all taken part in the Easter Tournament, competing in basketball and/or softball.

Joshua values participating in the Easter Tournament as it provides an opportunity to connect with his peers, seek guidance from older generations, and serve as a role model for those who follow.

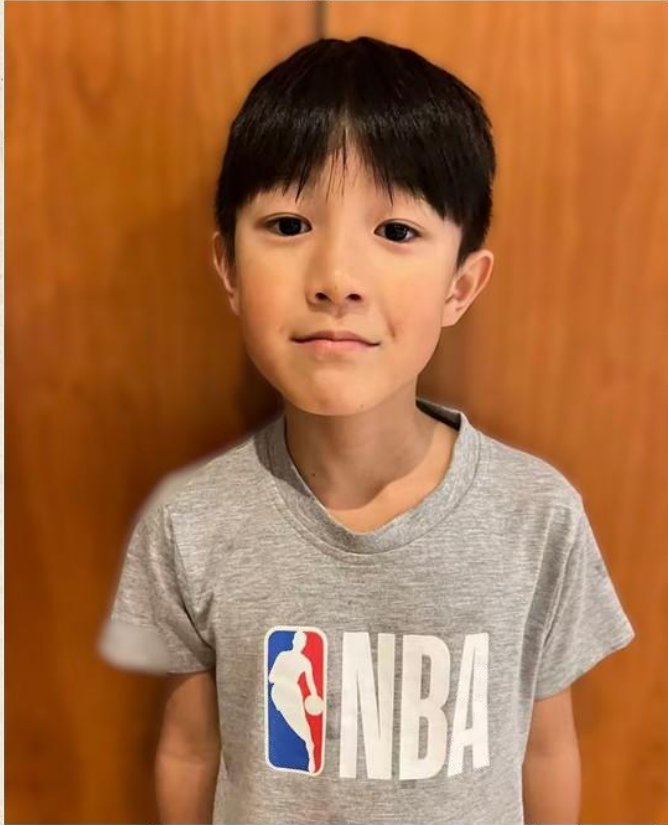


Bing-Yu Chloe Kuo



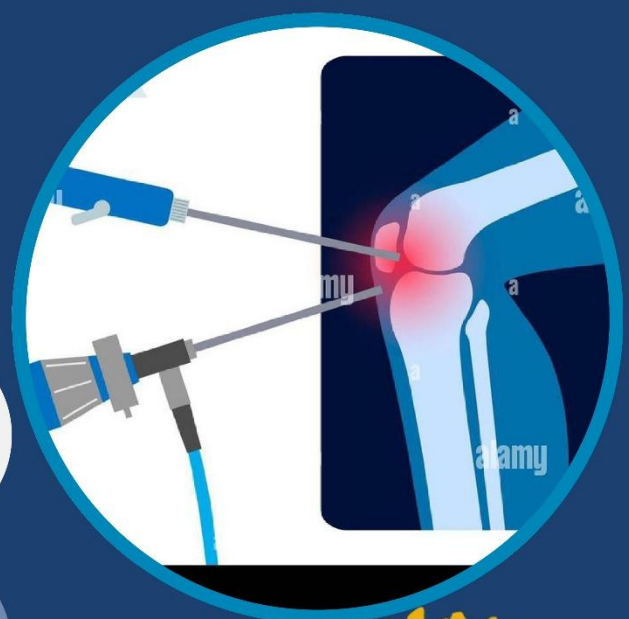

Mini Basketball Rules


1. All players must be turning 13 years or under in the calendar year of the tournament to qualify for the Mini division.
2. Teams may comprise of male and female players only, or a mixture.
3. 4 quarters will be played, 10 minutes running time for each quarter.
4. 2 minutes in between quarters, 3 minutes between halves.
5. All players play at least ONE quarter, and not more than THREE.
6. In the case of a team having 7 players, 1 player may play all four, and in the case of 6 players, 2 players may play 4 quarters.
7. The three points rules do not apply.
8. Each player is allowed 5 personal fouls, and each team is allowed 4 fouls per quarter, before the bonus free-throws come into effect. (as per senior rules).
9. No timeouts are allowed during the first three quarters; however, each team is allowed one timeout in the 4th quarter.
10. Substitutions can only be made in between quarters, and during the timeout in the 4th quarter.
11. **All** substitutions during this time will be charged with a quarter. Please notify the table officials of your intentions to sub.
12. If a player is substituting for an injured player during a quarter, he/she will be charged a quarter as well.
13. In the case of overtime, 5 minutes running time will be played, and the 5 players that ended the game in regular time will start the overtime. No time-outs, or substitutions are allowed during overtime. In case of injury, any player that has not played all four quarters may substitute for the injured player.
14. In case of foul shots, players will shoot from the Mark area inside the key.

VOLLEYBALL - INDOOR

The Game

Indoor Volleyball is a team sport with two teams of six players separated by a net. The goal of the teams is to score points by grounding the ball on the other team's court with no more than 3 touches of the ball. Each player has a specific position on the court, being outside hitter, opposite, setter, middle blocker, libero. Volleyball is a non-physical sport that can be played from as young as 8 years old. The types of teams vary from mixed juniors, junior ladies and men's, mixed seniors, senior ladies and men's or a mixture of juniors and seniors. FIVB (Fédération Internationale de Volleyball) is the international governing body for all forms of volleyball. VSA (Volleyball South Africa), an affiliate of FIVB, is the governing body of volleyball in South Africa under which provincial and regional bodies fall under. Leagues and tournaments are held locally and provincially by these bodies which are supported and attended by affiliated clubs. There are many volleyball clubs in and around Johannesburg and Cape Town, for example Spiker-Roo Volleyball Club in Johannesburg and Bikey Volleyball Club in Cape Town, which all have SACSA members. Volleyball has been a SACSA sport since 1990.
